We operate a fleet of water tankers to deliver non-drinking water to sites across the North West.

Our water can be used for toilet facilities, drains testing, barrier filling, swimming pool filling and many more uses.

We can also include chlorine dioxide tablets with the delivery for a small additional cost, which provide additional purification.





Water bowser hire

We hire static water bowsers in 1,000L and 2,000L capacities. Our **WRAS-approved** bowsers provide UV protection to reduce the build-up of algae. Our bowsers are also:

- made from a seamless potable-approved polymer material
- designed as a one-piece moulding
- suitable for domestic, agricultural and commercial use
- complete with a lockable lid
- delivered with a ball valve and 15mm Pushfit outlet

Frequently asked questions

How much water can you deliver?

We can deliver up to 9,000L in one visit and up to 30,000L per day.

Is your water drinking water?

Our water is not suitable for drinking. Whilst it originates from the mains supply and we regularly test our water for legionella, coliform, E.coli and general bacteria to ensure that the water we provide is as clean as can be, the risk of cross-contamination does still exist and so it is not labelled as drinking water and should not be used as such.

When can you deliver?

We generally aim for a next-day delivery service but can very often accommodate same-day deliveries, too.

What access do you need to deliver?

We deliver water using 18 tonnes HGVs and will need to be able to park within 30m of the vessel being filled. IBCs and bowsers are delivered using 3.5 tonnes vehicles with tail lifts.

What size is an IBC?

IBCs are roughly 1 cubic metre and hold around 1,000L of water.

What does WRAS-approved mean?
